

Classic New England Hikes, by the Man Who's Hiked Them All



Outdoor writer Jeff Romano will present a slideshow-illustrated talk showcasing favorite local hikes from his latest book, *100 Classic Hikes in New England*. The book features 100 iconic "can't miss" hikes many along the rocky coast of Maine and others deep in the Maine's heartland. Sometimes called the most comprehensive and up-to-date hiking guide for all of New England, the book features color photos, maps, and descriptions of scenic trails for all levels of fitness and abilities.
